Anchor Partner

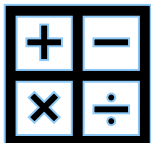
Fundamental Role:

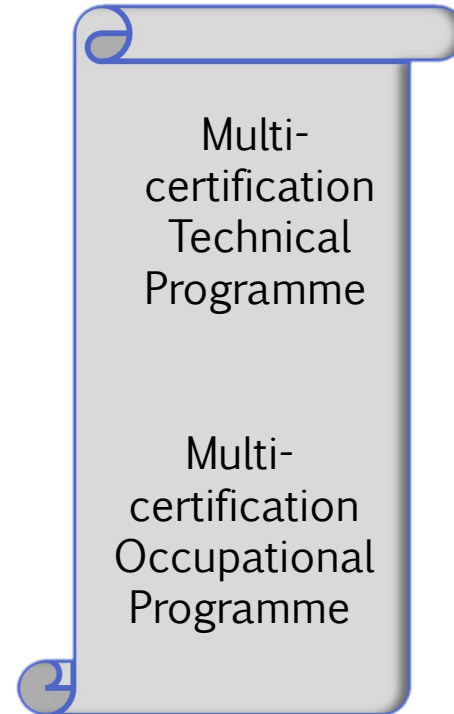
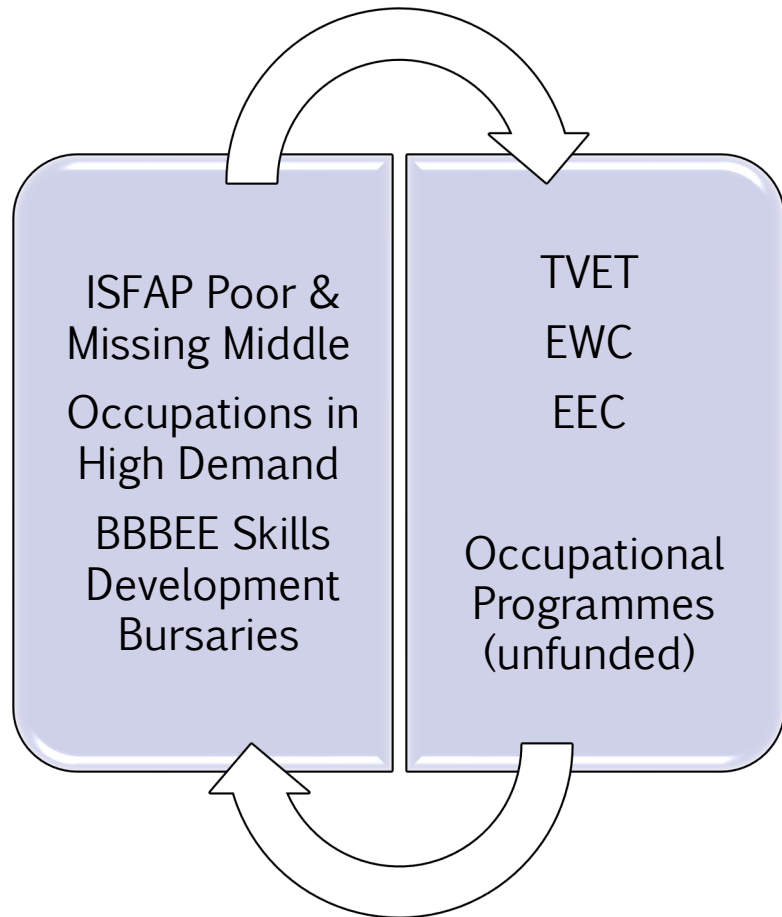

Multi-Certification Technical & Occupational Programmes

Secondary Schools offering technical subjects are strategically positioned to respond to the critical skills shortage and job creation identified as key to social and economic development.

A learner offered technical subjects entering the FET phase will go through a specialised occupation-based learning programme aimed at building skills that have economic value, create employability and entrepreneurship (should as far as possible incorporate at least one unit standard).

By the time that learner exits Grade 12 they would have acquired

accredited training/service provider.

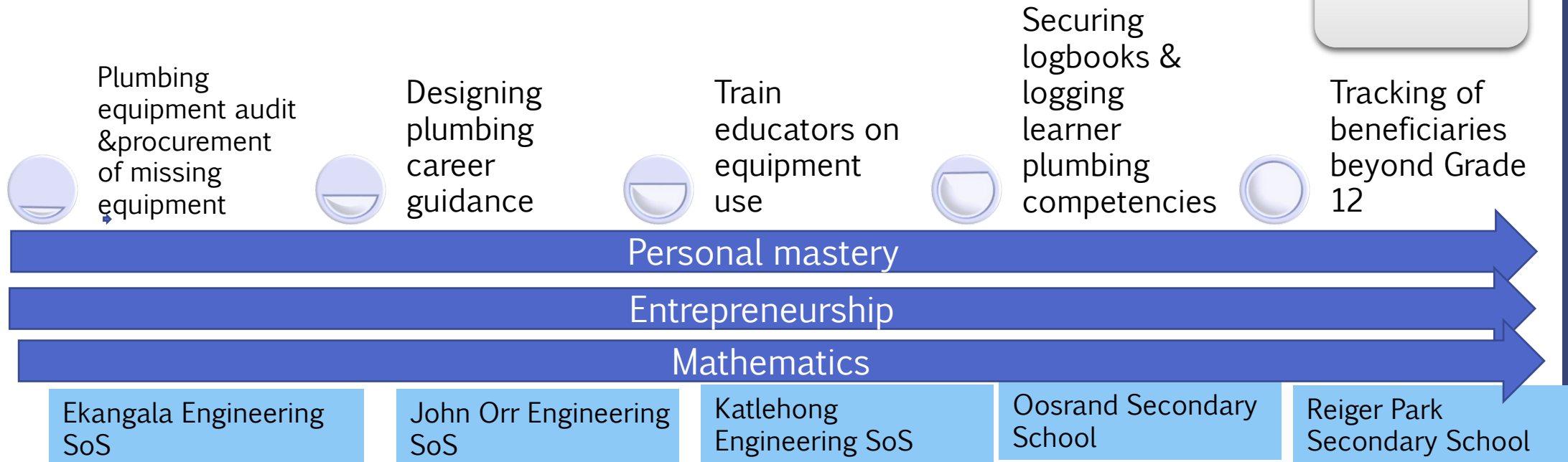


This ultimately could lead to a qualification on the NQF.

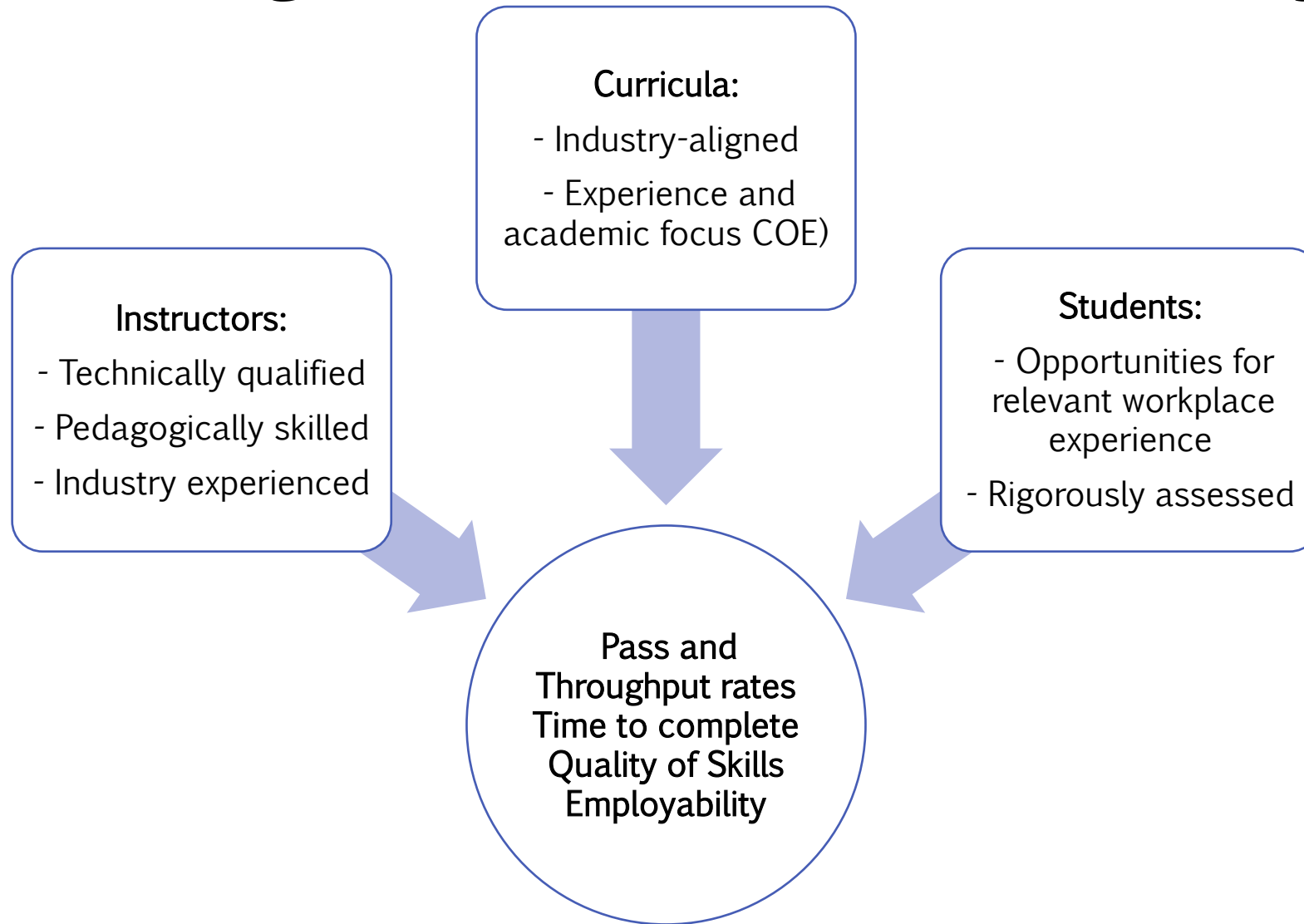
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Example of scaling in - Sasol interested to support 6 schools in Gauteng

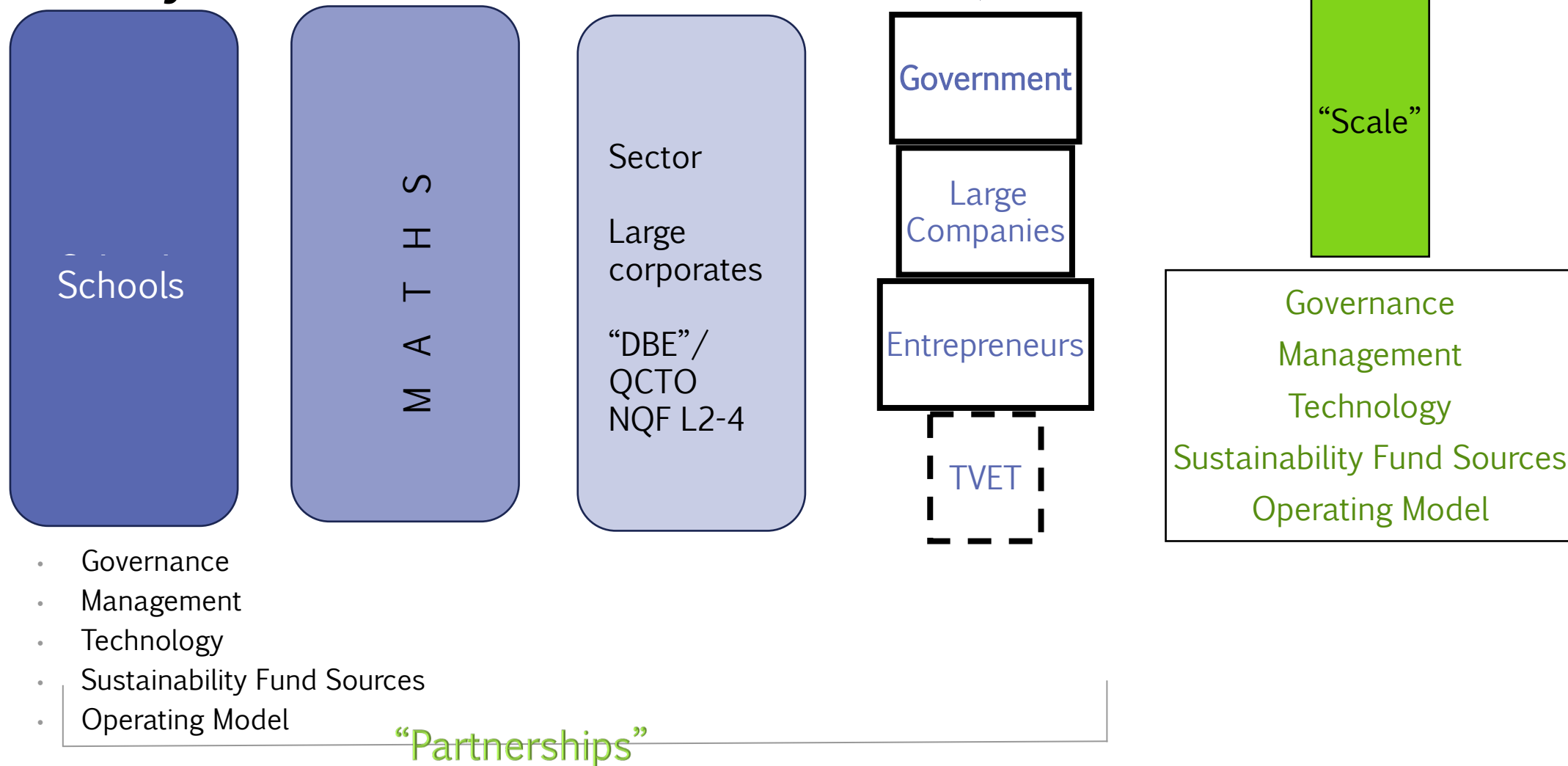
